

### **WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1**

**10 a.m. – 12 p.m. DEVIL’S DEN TRAIL GUIDED HIKE** – Join Park Interpreter Rebekah to learn how the caves and crevices were formed – and much more on this 1.5 mile, moderately strenuous hike. Meet at the Visitor Center flagpole.

### **THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 2**

**9 – 11 a.m. MORNING WALK TO YELLOW ROCK** - This hike speaks for itself! Join Interpreter Rebekah for a moderately strenuous hike to one of the most beautiful vistas in the state! Meet at the trailhead near Camp Area A.

**4 – 4:45 p.m. HIKE THROUGH TIME** – Join Park Interpreter Adam as we take a hike through time on the CCC Trail. We will see where the CCC lived in the park and imagine what life was like for them. Meet at the chimney by the playground for this easy hike.

### **FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 3**

**10 – 11:30 a.m. FOSSIL FLATS HIKE** – Join Park Interpreter Adam for a hike along the Fossil Flats Trail. We will meet at the trailhead at area A for this hilly hike that will take us along the creek and down to some fossils in the exposed creek bed. Please bring water and wear sturdy shoes.

**1– 2 p.m. LAKE TRAIL HIKE:** Join Park Interpreter Adam for a hike along the Lake Trail. We will discover the other side of the CCC Dam as well as find out why the water in the park is the teal green color. Meet at the suspension bridge by the playground.

**2:30 – 3 p.m. SUPER SENSES GAME** – Join Interpreter Rebekah to test your knowledge of natural objects and your super sensory powers in this fun game! Meet at the Café Pavilion

**4 – 5 p.m. DEVIL’S DEN SOFTBALL** – Everyone is invited to join Interpreters Rebekah and Adam for softball. Come be a part of this living legacy! We have gloves, bats, and balls, but we need you for a game! Meet at the ball field in Camp Area E.

## **SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 4**

**10 – 11 a.m. MEET THE TREES OF DEVIL’S DEN** - Each tree is unique! Join Rebekah for a short walk and fun riddle game to see which trees you might already know on the park and to meet some new ones! Meet at the Woody Plant Trailhead near the softball field in Camp Area E.

**1:30 – 2 p.m. REPTILES AND AMPHIBIANS** – Meet Park Interpreter Adam for a program on the slithering, crawling, and hopping creatures that occur in the park. There may even be live animals. Meet at the Audio/Visual Room at the Visitor Center.

**2:30 – 3 p.m. ANIMAL TRACKS** – Animals can be hard to spot, but they leave signs of their presence. Meet Interpreter Rebekah at the Café Pavilion to test your knowledge of animal tracks and make your own identification card.

We will be using a seine to catch fish, crawfish, and whatever else we can catch. We will identify them and let them go. If you want to take an active part in this program dress to get your feet wet.

**3:30 – 4:30 p.m. LEE CREEK TRAIL** – Join Park Interpreter Adam for a hike along the Lee Creek Trail. This hike makes its way through the creek so please wear sturdy shoes that can get wet for walking in the creek.
